Both Nevada chapters of the Associated General Contractors (AGC) are participating in a coalition which has retained The Road Information Program (TRIP) to evaluate Nevada's transportation future funding needs, as well as the condition, use and safety of our roads and bridges. TRIP, which was founded in 1971, is a Washington D.C. based nonprofit organization that promotes transportation policies which relieve traffic congestion, improve air quality, make highway travel safer and enhance economic productivity.
