AN ACT relating to the Department of Cultural Affairs; eliminating the requirement that the State Library and Archives be open to the public during certain days and hours; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

- 1 This bill eliminates the requirement in existing law that the State Library and
2 Archives be open for the use of the public for at least 5 days in each week and for at
3 least 8 hours in each day with the exception of legal holidays. (NRS 378.070)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 378.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 378.070 The State Library and Archives Administrator may
3 designate the hours that the State Library and Archives must be
4 open for the use of the public . ~~[, but they must be open for at least 5~~
5 ~~days in each week and for at least 8 hours in each day with the~~
6 ~~exception of legal holidays.]~~
7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
