## **SUMMARIES OF MEASURES**

### **RESOLUTION FILE**

S.C.R. 37—Provides for the Interim Finance Committee to conduct a review of Nevada's revenue structure and to provide long-term stabilization of revenue.  
(BDR R-1334)

### **GENERAL FILE**

S.B. 418—Reduces the period for bringing an action to enforce certain provisions relating to unclaimed property. (BDR S-1302)

### **VETOED BILLS**

A.B. 119—Requires the comprehensive regional plan in certain counties to include provisions concerning the sustainability of certain water resources. (BDR 22-750)

A.B. 267—Requires certain golf courses assessed as open-space real property to be designated as open-space real property under applicable zoning ordinances.  
(BDR 32-640)

A.B. 307—Revises provisions governing the publication of certain information relating to property taxes. (BDR 32-714)

A.B. 473—Revises provisions relating to medical and dental services for prisoners.  
(BDR 16-1128)

A.B. 491—Makes various changes concerning the execution on property of a judgment debtor or defendant. (BDR 2-948)

S.B. 201—Authorizes certain counties to impose additional taxes on fuels for motor vehicles. (BDR 32-233)

A.J.R. 1—Proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to revise the provisions governing a petition for a state initiative or referendum. (BDR C-710)
