Pursuant to Emergency Directive 006, section 1, there will be no physical location for the meeting.

Information on joining the meeting will be provided on the Agenda for the Commission Meeting.

The Colorado River Commission of Nevada (Commission) will hold a public hearing at 1:30 PM, on February 9, 2021. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the Repeal of a Regulation that pertains to chapter 538 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

1. The need for and the purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment.

The Commission is proposing to repeal NAC 538.060 which specifies the physical location of the Commission's office and the hours that the Commission's office will be open. The regulation was added in 1985 and since that time, the Commission has need for flexibility in choosing the precise location in Clark County of its office. The schedule requirement has also become outdated.

2. Either the terms or the substance of the regulations to be adopted, amended or repealed, or a description of the subjects and issues involved.

~~NAC 538.060 Office of Commission. The principal office of the Commission is located at 555 East Washington Avenue, Suite 3100, Las Vegas, Nevada. The office of the Commission will be open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day except on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday.~~

If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Commission may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.
