Discussion of Amendments to the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 422 and Solicitation of Public Comments

- 1. Subject: Proposed additions to the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 422.
  - (a) NAC 422 describes the program limits, eligibility and distribution of the Disproportionate Share Hospital (DSH) program. The purpose of the proposed amendments to NAC 422 are to revise the methodology for calculating and distributing DSH payments; set forth the documentation required from hospitals for the calculation and distribution of DSH payments; revise the procedures for adjusting a DSH payment, if according to audit, the amount paid to the hospital was greater than the amount it was entitled; and revise the procedures for redistributing any DSH payments returned to the DHCFP.

Section 3 is being added. This section describes the documentation required from hospitals for the calculation of the DSH payments.

NAC 422.115 is being amended to revise the methodology of DSH payments calculation. This section also adds the definition of a DSH limit.

NAC 422.135 is being amended to revise the methodology of distributing DSH payments within a hospital pool.

NAC 422.155 is being amended to revise the process of recalculating and redistributing DSH payments after an audit.

NAC 422.025, NAC 422.045 and NAC 422.125 are being repealed as they describe existing regulations relating to the calculation and distribution of the DSH payments which are being replaced.

(b) Public comments limited to 5 minutes per person.

There is no projected State General Fund fiscal impact as a result of these amendments. DSH funding is based on an allotment set by the Federal Government.

Only one of the current DSH eligible hospitals, Mt. Grant General Hospital, meets the statutory definition of a small business. . The new methodology results in a very slight increase in DSH payments for this hospital, but the increase is negligible and based on a projected allotment.
