

## **NOTICE OF WORKSHOP TO SOLICIT COMMENTS ON PROPOSED REGULATION**

The Nevada Department of Wildlife is proposing the adoption of regulations pertaining to Chapters 502 and 503 of the Nevada Administrative Code. A workshop has been set at 10:30 a.m., on November 14, 2014 at the Truckee Meadows Community College, 7000 Dandini Blvd., Sierra Building Room 108, Reno, Nevada. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulation:

**Commission General Regulation 416 – LCB File No. R155-12 – Shed Antlers** – The Commission will consider a regulation relating to shed antlers; allowing a person to take shed antlers from the field during an open season and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Commission General Regulation 453 – LCB File No. R113-14 – First Come First Serve Bonus Point -** The Commission will consider a regulation relating to wildlife; regarding making an exception in the bonus point program and not have the loss of bonus points occur in the bonus point categories if the applicant is successful in first come first serve draw for a tag; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Commission General Regulation 454 – (Temporary T005-14) – Firearm Carrying During Archery Hunt** – The Commission will consider a regulation relating to the carry of a firearm in the field while hunting under archery regulations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
