<u>Point</u> - The Commission will consider a regulation relating to wildlife; regarding making an exception in the bonus point program and not have the loss of bonus points occur in the bonus point categories if the applicant is successful in first come first serve draw for a tag; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

<u>Commission General Regulation 454 – (Temporary T005-14) – Firearm Carrying During Archery Hunt – The Commission will consider a regulation relating to the carry of a firearm in the field while hunting under archery regulations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.</u>
