Small Business Impact Statement

The Nevada Housing Division of the Department of Business & Industry has proposed changes to the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) chapters 489 regarding the establishment of an expedited.

The purpose of the proposed changes to the regulations is to:

 Establish a process pursuant to which an individual may submit an application to the Division for an expedited issuance of a certificate of title for a mobile home, manufactured home, or commercial coach and establish a fee for such application, review and issuance.

The Division made a concerted effort to determine whether the regulation is likely to "[i]mpose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business" or "[d]irectly restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business." NRS 233B.0608(1). The Division concluded the regulation would not cause these negative impacts or effects, after consultation with internal staff and the Division's Legal Counsel. While the Division determined that no Small Business Impact Statement (SBIS) was required, the Division is submitting the following information to reflect how it might respond if a SBIS were determined required.

RE: NRS 233B.0609 Proposed permanent or temporary regulation: Contents of small business impact statement; person responsible for agency to sign impact statement.

1. A description of the manner in which comment was solicited from affected small businesses, a summary of their response and an explanation of the manner in which other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.

No affected small businesses are impacted by this regulation.

2. The manner in which the analysis was conducted.

The manner in which the analysis was conducted was through reviewing and discussing of the draft regulation with Division staff, Division leadership, and the Division's attorney

3. The estimated economic effect of the proposed regulation on the small businesses which it is to regulate, including, without limitation:

Adverse effects: There are no adverse effects of this regulation on the businesses it regulates nor on the public.

Beneficial effects: This will allow the someone who desires a certificate of title for a manufactured home, mobile home, or commercial coach in an expedited manner to submit an application for such expedited certificate of title.

Immediate effects: This will allow individuals who need a certificate of title expediently to obtain such title in an expedient manner.

Long-term effects: The Division will more efficiently protect the public.

4. A description of the methods that the agency considered to reduce the impact of the proposed regulation on small businesses and a statement regarding whether the agency actually used any of those methods.

The methods the agency considered to reduce the impact of the proposed regulation on small businesses were via discussions with the Division staff and its legal counsel.

The agency did actually use these methods to formulate this approach and to confirm its probable impact of reduced costs and reduced labor.

- 5. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the proposed regulation.
- 6. If the proposed regulation provides a new fee or increases an existing fee, the total annual amount the agency expects to collect and the manner in which the money will be used.

A new fee is established to cover the costs of the Division for implementing the regulation.

7. If the proposed regulation includes provisions which duplicate or are more stringent than federal, state or local standards regulating the same activity, an explanation of why such duplicative or more stringent provisions are necessary.

The proposed regulations do not overlap or duplicate any regulation of other state or local governmental entities. The regulations, even after these proposed regulation changes are adopted, will not overlap and duplicate parts of a federal regulation. The Division is not aware of any proposed provisions which are more stringent than a federal regulation that regulates the same activity.

8. The reasons for the conclusions of the agency regarding the impact of a regulation on small businesses.

The reasons for the conclusions of the agency regarding the impact of a regulation on small businesses are the result of a review of the statutes, draft regulation and discussion among Division staff and legal counsel.

Section 1. NAC 489 is amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

- 1. An applicant seeking title of a manufactured home, mobile home or commercial coach pursuant to NRS 489.561 or 489.562 may submit an application to the Division for the expedited issuance of the certificate of title.
- 2. The applicant must submit:
 - a. An application on a form prescribed by the Division.
 - b. All information to demonstrate the circumstances of the case with the application.
 - c. The fee for the expedited service set forth in NAC 489.380
- 3. The applicant must respond to any requests by the Division for additional information within 5 business days of the request.
- 4. Upon receipt of the application and information set forth in subsection 2 and 3, the Division will review the information and if the Division is satisfied the applicant is entitled to the certificate of title, may issue the certificate of title within 7 business days.

Sec. 2. NAC 489.380 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 2. For each inspection or reinspection conducted more than 25 miles from the inspector's station of duty, the Division will charge, in addition to the fee listed, the inspector's actual expenses for time and travel.
- 3. The Division will collect a fee for the sale of reports not listed in subsection 1 based upon the cost to the Division to produce those reports, plus a minimum fee for handling of \$40 for the first report.

- 4. The Division will collect a fee for inspection, pursuant to a schedule established by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, from each manufacturer of manufactured homes who has a plant located in this State. The Division will pay the fee to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development.
- 5. As used in this section, "rent history" means the economic and demographic data collected by the Administrator pursuant to NRS 118B.025.
