## NOTICE OF HEARING FOR ADOPTION OF REGULATION OF THE STATE OF NEVADA BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

The Board of Wildlife Commissioners will hold a public hearing at 8:30 a.m., on Saturday, November 15, 2014 at the Truckee Meadows Community College, 7000 Dandini Blvd., Sierra Building Room 108, Reno, Nevada. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption of regulations. If a person who is directly affected by the proposed action fails to appear to request to make an oral presentation, the Board of Wildlife Commissioners may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

<u>Commission General Regulation 435 – LCB File No. R107-14 - Archery Cleanup –</u> The Commission will consider a regulation relating to hunting; authorizing the Department to issue an archery disability permit to a person with a permanent disability; revising the definition of "longbow" for certain purposes; revising the circumstances under which a person may use a crossbow to hunt a big game mammal or a bow to hunt a game mammal or game bird; authorizing a person to use a scope permit during a type of hunt that is restricted to bows; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

<u>Commission General Regulation 439 – LCB File NO. R108-14 - Water Ski Towable Device – The Commission will consider a regulation relating to watercraft; to clarify what is considered a towed device behind a vessel or restricted areas closed to water skiing for public safety in high use areas, narrow channels or certain bodies are not large enough to accommodate the activity.</u>

<u>Commission General Regulation 444 – LCB File No. R086-14 - Laughlin Fishermen's Access – The Commission will consider a regulation relating to watercraft; that will prohibit swimming or bathing around a dock or boat ramp or using a dock or boat ramp to swim or bathe; and docking a vessel or otherwise trespassing in a prohibited area at Laughlin Fishermen's Access.</u>

<u>Commission General Regulation 449 – LCB File No. R111-14 - Tannery/Taxidermist – The Commission will consider a regulation relating to taxidermy; authorizing a taxidermist who receives a taxidermic item from another taxidermist to maintain certain records in lieu of maintaining a record of the number of the tag, seal or permit for the taxidermic item; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.</u>

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Board of Wildlife Commissioners may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Secretary, Board of Wildlife Commissioners, 1100 Valley Road, Reno, Nevada 89512. Written submissions must be received by the Secretary, Board of Wildlife Commissioners at least five days before the scheduled public hearing.
