**LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES TO MEET IN FALLON  
ON REDISTRICTING AND K-12 BUDGET**

The Nevada Legislature will hold committee meetings in Fallon on Thursday, March 24, 2011, to receive testimony from the general public on redistricting and on the K-12 education budget for the next two school years. The hearings will provide rural Nevadans the opportunity to have their thoughts on these two critical issues heard.

The Senate and Assembly Committees on Legislative Operations and Elections will meet at the Fallon Convention Center, from 4 p.m. to 5 p.m. to offer area residents an opportunity to make suggestions on redrawing the district boundaries of congressional districts and state legislative districts, as well as Board of Regents, State Board of Education, and petition districts.

The Joint Subcommittee on K-12 Education and Higher Education, a subcommittee of the Senate Committee on Finance and the Assembly Committee on Ways and Means, will meet at the same location from 5:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. to get input on school funding.

All interested Nevada residents are invited to attend one of these meetings and present their suggestions and concerns about reapportionment and redistricting or about the proposed K-12 budget. All members of the Legislative Operations and Elections Committees and the Subcommittee on K-12 Education and Higher Education are expected to attend.
