As mandated under the Education Reform Act passed by the 1997 legislature, enclosed is a copy of the *Report on Summer and Fall 2009 Remedial/Developmental Enrollments* that includes data on recent high school graduates enrolled in remedial courses within the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE). This information will be shared with the NSHE Board of Regents and forwarded to the Nevada Department of Education, Legislative Counsel Bureau and Nevada High School Principals.

The report includes information only for students who graduated from a Nevada high school during the period September 2008 to August 2009 and who enrolled in at least one remedial course at a NSHE institution in either the summer or fall of 2009. The report includes information on costs associated with the remedial enrollments and the type of remedial courses in which the students enrolled.





#### Introduction

In 1997, the Nevada Legislature approved Senate Bill 482 (Chapter 473, *Statutes of Nevada* 1997) directing the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE) to provide certain information to Nevada school districts on enrollments in remedial courses within the NSHE and on the costs associated with providing that instruction. Codified in *Nevada Revised Statutes* (NRS) 396.548, the mandate states the following:

The Board of Regents shall require employees of the System to provide to the Board of Trustees of each school district of this state, as appropriate, information regarding the:

- 1. Number of pupils who graduated from a high school in the district in the immediately preceding year and enrolled in remedial courses in reading, writing or mathematics at a university, state college or community college within the System.
- 2. Costs incurred by the System in providing remedial instruction pursuant to subsection 1.

The data necessary to satisfy this requirement are collected from the NSHE institutions and are summarized in this report. The information is provided to both the school districts and to the individual secondary schools, as appropriate, along with information regarding the placement methods utilized by the institutions of the NSHE.

This report includes information on students who graduated from a Nevada high school between September 2008 and August 2009 ("recent high school graduates") and who enrolled in at least one remedial course at an NSHE institution in Summer or Fall 2009. The report excludes any data for which a positive match to a Nevada high school could not be made. This report includes statistics on remediation rates by ethnicity, high school, and district.

In addition to recent Nevada high school graduates, there are other students who require remediation in order to participate successfully in college-level courses. NSHE institutions enroll a significant number of older, returning students who require remediation. As shown in the summary tables in this report, it is interesting to note that the majority of students enrolled in remediation, particularly those at the community colleges, are not recent high school students. In placing students in remedial courses, each institution is subject to Board policy as well as institution-specific policies on remediation.

For the purposes of this report, the cost of providing remedial instruction is calculated at a per-credit cost for community colleges (\$232) and a higher per-credit cost for the state college (\$384). Cost calculations are determined using the *2009-10 State-Supported Operating Budget* and projected FTE for each institution. As of Fall 2006, NSHE universities no longer receive state-funding for remedial courses. Courses offered to students by the universities are done so on a self-funded basis only. Therefore, the cost to the state for delivery of remedial coursework at the universities

is not included in the overall cost calculation. UNR and UNLV continue to offer remedial coursework as self-supporting and enrollments are included in this report.

#### Policies on Student Placement in Remedial Courses

The Board of Regents of the Nevada System of Higher Education established policies for placement of students into appropriate English and mathematics courses. The following guidelines were in effect for the Fall 2009 semester:

NSHE Board of Regents' *Handbook* Title 4, Chapter 16, Section 1

- 1. The Nevada System of Higher Education reserves the right to cancel the admission or registration of any individual whose attendance at a university or college, in the opinion of the appropriate administrative officer and the President, would not be mutually beneficial to that individual and the university or college.
- 2. Placement testing should take place prior to matriculation. Additionally, English and mathematics testing must take place no more than two years prior to matriculation.
- 3. All degree-seeking students who place in developmental/remedial coursework must take the prescribed sequence of courses until remediation is completed. Beginning Fall 2007, students requiring remediation must complete all required coursework prior to completion of 30 college-level credits unless otherwise authorized by the institution.
- 4. Initial placement into English courses in the Nevada System of Higher Education will be based upon standardized test scores as noted below. Additional placement will be determined through formal assessment of students including departmental diagnostic writing and/or reading tests, submission of writing samples, and/or a student portfolio for evaluation by faculty, as determined by each institution's English department. Accuplacer, Compass, or other appropriate placement procedures may be used for English placement at the community colleges in lieu of the ACT or SAT.

Initial placement into mathematics courses in the Nevada System of Higher Education will be based upon standardized test scores as noted below or equivalent criteria through formal assessment of students including departmental diagnostic tests as determined by each institution's mathematics' department. Accuplacer, Compass, or other appropriate placement procedures may be used for mathematics placement at the community colleges in lieu of the ACT or SAT.

#### Trends in Remedial Enrollment

This report includes information regarding the enrollment of recent Nevada high school graduates in remedial/developmental English and/or mathematics courses from 2005 to 2009. It is important to note that the data herein are for recent high school graduates only (students that graduated between September and August of the year immediately preceding their enrollment at an NSHE institution). This report does not focus on the number of other students who require or elect remediation, but who do not fall into the category of "recent Nevada high school graduate." Only 19.6 percent of the students enrolled in remedial courses during the 2009 Summer or Fall semesters were 2008-09 Nevada high school graduates.


Systemwide, 32.6 percent of all recent Nevada high school graduates who attended NSHE institutions were enrolled in at least one remedial course in Summer or Fall 2009, a decrease from 33.5 percent last year. Of the 2,943 recent Nevada high school graduates enrolled in remedial courses, 900 or 30.6 percent took both remedial mathematics and remedial English. Most remedial students, 69.4 percent, needed remediation in only one subject area.

It should be noted that students enrolled at both a four-year institution and a community college are reported only once in the systemwide figures. In some cases, a student is enrolled in a remedial course at the community college while pursuing their regular academic studies at the four-year institution. For this reason, the total number of recent Nevada high school graduates enrolled across the NSHE institutions is reduced through the removal of duplicate enrollments to provide an accurate count.

#### **NSHE**

Beginning with a drop in Fall 2006, the remediation rate for recent Nevada high school graduates the semester following high school graduation has continued to decline to 32.6 percent in 2009. Effective for the Fall 2006 semester, the admission criteria for the NSHE universities increased, resulting in better academically-prepared high school graduates enrolling at these institutions. Also effective as of Fall 2006, NSHE universities no longer received state funding for remedial courses. Both of these factors impacted the number of students enrolled in remedial courses.

In Fall 2000, nationally, 42 percent of entering freshmen at degree-granting public 2-year institutions enrolled in remedial courses and 20 percent at public 4-year institutions, which puts current NSHE remedial enrollment of 39.9 percent at the community colleges lower than that national rate and the remedial enrollment of 22.7 percent at the universities higher than that national rate.<sup>1</sup>

The charts below provide an overview of remedial enrollment trends at the universities, state college, and community colleges of the NSHE for students who graduated from a Nevada high school during the 2008-09 academic year.



#### Universities

Effective Fall 2006 state funding for remedial courses at the universities was eliminated, resulting in an overall decrease in remedial course offerings. After experiencing a decline in 2006, the enrollment of recent Nevada high school graduates in remedial courses at the universities remained relatively stable until this year when remedial enrollments at UNLV increased.

Effective Fall 2007, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was established between CSN and UNLV that limited UNLV's remedial course offerings to those offered online only and allowed CSN to offer remedial courses to UNLV students on the UNLV campus. Following Fall 2008 the MOU expired, and as a result UNLV increased the number of remedial course sections offered to compensate for the loss in courses that were previously provided by CSN. At the same time, this resulted in fewer remedial sections offered by CSN. In general, this shift of remedial enrollments (from CSN to UNLV) resulted in UNLV's increased remedial rate for Fall 2009 and the decline in CSN's remedial rate. Remedial enrollments at UNR increased consistently every year from 2003 until they peaked in 2007 at which point they began to decline.

#### **State College**


NSC does not offer courses in remedial English. In lieu of remedial English courses, NSC offers a 5-credit, college-level composition course. A written English placement exam is given to students with an ACT score of less than 21, an SAT score of less than 510 in English, and to students who have not taken the ACT or SAT. Ratings on the exam range from one to four. Students who receive a rating of less than two are referred to a community college. Students with a rating of two or greater are offered the opportunity to take NSC's English 100. Successful completion (grade C or higher) of the course allows a student to place directly into English 102.

The data in this report concern the college's remedial mathematics enrollments only. The number of recent high school graduates enrolled in a remedial math course increased notably from 52.6 percent in 2008 to 72.8 percent in 2009. This increase coincided with the use by NSC of a new placement exam developed by math faculty in Fall 2008. Under Board policy an institution may utilize departmental diagnostic tests as determined by their mathematics' department.

The math department pilot tested student performance on the exam by first administering it as an exit exam to students in various math classes to ensure it properly assesses student performance and then to incoming students where it affirmed the results from their ACT and SAT scores. Based on the results of the pilot tests, NSC believes that the new placement exam is a more accurate assessment of student preparation for college-level math, and the math department is carefully monitoring pass rates of students in college-level courses. However, because of the high placement into remedial mathematics courses, NSC is continuing to review the exam.

Recent Nevada High School Graduates Enrolled in Math Remediation Immediately Following Graduation (2005-2009)




#### **Community Colleges**

Overall, the remediation rates of recent Nevada high school graduates at NSHE community colleges decreased in Fall 2009 to 39.9 percent. The remedial enrollments decreased at CSN by 10.6 percentage points and at WNC by 3.2. The decrease at CSN is due to the increased remedial course offerings at UNLV upon conclusion of the MOU between the two institutions that allowed CSN to deliver remedial courses to UNLV students at the UNLV campus. The remedial enrollments at TMCC overall have remained consistent with a slight increase in 2009, while at GBC the remedial enrollments have steadily increased since 2006.

#### **Persistence Rates**

One measure of student success is retention or persistence. Systemwide retention measures allow NSHE to track students who may have enrolled at a community college solely to pursue remedial coursework into enrollment at any NSHE institution. Using these systemwide measures, persistence to a second semester of study is consistent between students who enroll in remedial coursework, whether English, math or both, and students who are not enrolled in remediation. When compared to students not enrolling in remedial courses, remediating students are just as likely as other students to return for a second semester of coursework.

#### Remediation Rates – Millennium Scholarship Recipients

Historically, the remediation rate for Millennium Scholars has been consistently lower than that of non-Millennium students. Of the recent high school graduates included in this report only 22.7 percent of the Millennium Scholars compared to 41.4 percent of the non-Millennium students enrolled in remedial courses during the Summer or Fall of 2009.

The eligibility criteria for the Millennium Scholarship increased to a 3.1 high school GPA effective Fall 2005 and again increased to a 3.25 effective Fall 2007. The effect of these changes is a reduction in the number of Millennium scholars who enrolled in NSHE institutions, but also a decrease in the remediation rate of the Millennium Scholars. The increased eligibility criteria for the Millennium Scholarship had a similar effect as that of the raised admission requirements to the universities that went into effect in Fall 2007 and again in Fall 2008; namely, to increase the academic preparedness of students.


#### **Remediation Rates by Ethnicity**

The overall remediation rate for NSHE decreased approximately one percentage point from the prior year. However, the pattern of remediation rates by ethnic/racial categories remains consistent from the previous year with the American Indian/Alaskan Native category having the highest remediation rate. For 2009, the percent of students requiring remediation is similar for Black, White, and Hispanic students, while Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander and Asian students continue to have the lowest remediation rate.

#### A Look Back at 2007-08 High School Graduates

The NSHE Remedial Report is published in the winter following the Fall term of enrollment. As a result of the reporting schedule, the report includes high school graduates enrolled in remediation the summer or fall following graduation as that is the current data available. Per Board of Regents policy, students must complete all required coursework prior to completion of 30 college-level credits. Therefore, some students may defer their enrollment in remedial courses to the spring semester following high school graduation or beyond depending upon their enrollment load. For this reason, the actual remedial enrollments may be lower than those reported following the fall semester with data available at that time. This and future reports will revise the previous report's summer and fall remedial data with remedial enrollments occurring by those high school graduates the following spring semester. The following table shows remedial enrollments of 2007-08 high school graduates in summer or fall 2008 as reported in last year's report updated with those students who had no remedial enrollments during the summer or fall of 2008 but did have remedial enrollments the following spring semester, Spring 2009. The cost of these additional enrollments at the community colleges and Nevada State College was \$118,783.

#### Conclusion and Changes in Remedial Cut-Off Scores Effective Fall 2010

Systemwide student enrollment in remedial courses has declined consistently since 2005. However, while the overall remedial enrollment continues to decline, there exist considerable variations in remedial enrollments by institution. Numerous factors may be noted in explaining the overall decline and in the institutional variation. The elimination of state funding for remedial courses at the universities and the establishment and subsequent expiration of an MOU between UNLV and CSN allowing CSN to offer remedial courses on the UNLV campus have contributed to the fluctuations in remedial enrollments noted at those institutions. Further, the differences between the institutions in the use of remedial placement tools and test scores used to place students in college-level math and English courses contributed to the variation in placement rates across institutions.

Given the institutional variations in placement methods and the fluctuating remedial enrollments in August 2008, the System began a formal review of the current policy, including a review of national data, in an effort to set appropriate and uniform cut-off scores to be used in remedial placement. Ultimately, the review concluded with the Board of Regents establishing a new policy, effective Fall 2010, that sets uniform scores for specific standardized tests and commonly used remedial placement tools (i.e. ACT, SAT, Accuplacer, and Compass). The process of amending the policy took over 18 months and was completed in two phases. Phase one focused on established benchmark scores for the ACT and SAT. Phase two expanded the policy to include cut-off scores for the most commonly used test at the community colleges, Accuplacer; and additional scores for Compass.

Phase one began with a review of the *College Readiness Benchmarks* established by ACT. The *College Readiness Benchmark Score* is the minimum score in a specific subject area determined by ACT to indicate a 50 percent chance of obtaining a B or higher or about a 75 percent change of obtaining a C or higher in the corresponding entry-level credit-bearing college course. These scores were empirically derived using national ACT data on the actual performance of students in college. Based on this data, the remedial cut scores for the ACT will be for math a score of at least 22 and for English a score of at least 18. In effect, the ACT cut-score for mathematics will increase from 21 to 22 and the ACT English cut-score will decrease from 21 to 18. It is anticipated that the reduction in the ACT English cut-score will result in fewer students being placed in remedial English – the actual outcome of which will be reviewed in next year's report following the formal implementation of the policy.

ACT and SAT are not equivalent tests, and therefore staff could not ascertain an equivalent SAT score from the recommended ACT score. During the course of developing the policy proposal, system administration staff relied on the expertise of university faculty who provided the recommendations for the SAT English and mathematics cut scores. Faculty recommended an SAT critical reading score of at least 440 for placement in a college-level English course and an SAT math score of at least 500 for placement in a college-level mathematics course.

Phase two of this process expanded the policy revisions to include benchmark scores for Accuplacer and Compass, tests more commonly used by the community colleges for remedial placement. According to the College Board, certain score ranges established for the Accuplacer Sentence Skills test are indicative of skill level. Based on those established ranges, cut-scores were determined. The cut-score for Compass, an ACT based exam, was determined using equivalent scores to those recommended by ACT for the standardized mathematics and English tests. Similar to the scores established in Phase one, these scores are also effective in Fall 2010.

While this revised policy establishes specific benchmark scores, the policy does not preclude an institution from using an alternative placement tool if supported by institutional research. Following the fall semester of implementation and thereafter, System staff and faculty will review student success rates at each institution in an effort to discern if these scores have been appropriately set. In the meantime, it is anticipated that the revisions of these cut-scores will impact remedial rates in the coming years.

Following is the revised NSHE remedial policy, effective Fall 2010:

NSHE Board of Regents' Handbook

Title 4, Chapter 16, Section 1 (effective Fall 2010)

The remedial policies of the Nevada System of Higher Education are intended to ensure a foundation of knowledge and competencies that will assist students in successfully pursuing and attaining an academic degree. Students are strongly encouraged to prepare for the rigors of higher education prior to entering the NSHE.

- 1. Pursuant to federal regulations, institutions may make ability-to-benefit determinations using federally approved tests and passing scores to receive federal student aid. The Nevada System of Higher Education reserves the right to cancel the admission or registration of any individual whose attendance at a university or college, in the opinion of the appropriate administrative officer and the President, would not be mutually beneficial, as determined by the ability-to-benefit test, to that individual and the university or college.
- 2. Placement testing should take place prior to matriculation. Additionally, English and mathematics testing must take place no more than two years prior to matriculation.
- 3. All degree-seeking students who place into developmental/remedial coursework must take the prescribed sequence of courses until remediation is completed. Students requiring remediation must complete all required coursework prior to completion of 30 college-level credits unless otherwise authorized by the institution.

- 4. English Placement. In order to be placed into a college-level English course, a student must achieve an ACT English score of at least 18 or an SAT critical reading score of at least 440. Universities and colleges may set other scores if supported by institutional research. Additional placement may also be determined through formal assessment of students including departmental diagnostic writing and/or reading tests, submission of writing samples, and/or a student portfolio for evaluation by faculty, as determined by each institution's English department. Accuplacer, Compass, or other appropriate placement tools may be used for English placement in lieu of the ACT or SAT.
- 5. Mathematics Placement. In order to be placed into a college-level mathematics course, a student must achieve an ACT Math score of at least 22 or an SAT Math score of at least 500. Universities and colleges may set other scores if supported by institutional research. Additional placement decisions may also be made through formal assessment of students including departmental diagnostic tests as determined by each institution's mathematics department. Accuplacer, Compass, or other appropriate placement tools may be used for mathematics placement in lieu of the ACT or SAT.
