SUBJECT: **Solicitation of Recommendations**

This memorandum is a reminder that the Legislative Committee on Public Lands is accepting written suggestions for recommended legislation, letters, and position statements for consideration during the Committee's final meeting of this interim.

I would also like to express my thanks to all those who have participated in our meetings in Carson City, Elko, Ely, and Las Vegas. The Committee has heard informative and useful testimony on a wide range of subjects related to public lands and water agencies, including:

- Activities and programs of the Bureau of Land Management, United States Department of the Interior, and the U.S. Forest Service;
- Activities and programs of the Division of Water Resources, State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources; the Colorado River Commission of Nevada; and other State agencies and public water authorities, districts, and systems;
- Control of invasive weeds and other plants;
- Issues and priorities of local governments relating to public lands in Nevada;
- Management of wild horses and burros;
- Policies related to the greater sage-grouse; and
- Prevention and suppression of wildfire.

The Committee is authorized to request a limited number of bills and resolutions for the 2013 Session, and may also write letters to key individuals and organizations and include position statements in its final report.

The final meeting and work session is currently scheduled for August 17, 2012, by simultaneous videoconference between Carson City and Las Vegas. Committee staff must receive your written suggestions, along with supporting background information, by Friday, July 20, 2012. Please be aware that submission of a suggestion does not guarantee its placement on the agenda for the work session.
