Information on the following is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.060:

- 1. NAC 632.190 is amended to increase fees for the Certified Nursing Assistant program
- 2. NAC 632.210 is amended to accurately reflect the Disability Advisory Committee's current mission.

NEVADA STATE BOARD OF NURSING

Proposed regulation changes to NAC 632.190 were approved in wording and concept by the Nevada State Board of Nursing on May 7, 2003 (A) and November 7, 2001 (B). They are:

A. NAC 632.190 is amended to increase fees for the Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) program.

This increase is needed to offset a decrease in the amount of federal funding received to administer the program and an increase in the cost of the program's discipline cases.

In the short-term, the proposed regulation change will have an adverse economic effect on individual CNAs, who will pay more for certification fees, and on businesses that run training programs for CNAs, which will pay more for approval and review fees. However, this is mitigated by the fact that most of the current fees have been at or near the bottom of the fee range since the Board was first given the statutory responsibility of regulating CNAs in 1989.

In the long-term, the proposed regulation change will have the beneficial effect of reducing the financial shortfall in the CNA program, thereby reducing the subsidy currently provided by RN and LPN licensure fees.

There will be no adverse or beneficial economic effects on the public, either in the short-term or in the long-term.

There will be no additional expense for enforcement of this regulation.

B. NAC 632.210 is amended to accurately reflect the Disability Advisory Committee's current mission.

There will be no economic effect of this regulation on businesses or individuals that are regulated by the applicable administrative code.

There will be no economic effect on the public.

There will be no additional expense for enforcement of this regulation.

Authority NRS 632.120, NRS 632.237

Amend NAC 632.210 to read:

632.210 Committee to advise board on nurses impaired by disability. The board will appoint a committee to advise and report to the board on matters related to supporting public protection and ensuring the safe practice of nurses who may have practiced pursuant to NAC 632.890(9), "Practicing nursing while with or without good cause, his physical, mental or emotional condition impairs his ability to act in a manner consistent with established or customary nursing standards, or both." The committee will assist in the board's Alternative Program for Chemically Dependent Nurses through ongoing education and evaluation and monitoring compliance with the board's approved policies related to the program. [nurses impaired by a disability.] The committee will consist of at least six persons who are knowledgeable concerning conditions, diagnoses, and/or addictions, which may affect nursing practice. [disabilities, including a] A member of the board or its designated representative [, who] shall serve as the chairperson.
