## NAC 503.510 Aquatic bait and live bait: Capture, sale, holding and transportation; reference work for naming of species. (NRS 501.105, 501.181, 503.310)

Sec. 2. In the Western Region, the capture of any fish used as live bait for sale from the Carson River drainage below Quilici Dam is prohibited. The Quilici Dam is located near Dayton, Nevada.

Sec. 3. The reference work from which the species listed in subsection 1 were named is special publication 12 of the American Fisheries Society, *A List of Common and Scientific Names of Fishes from the United States and Canada*, 4th ed., 1980.
