## PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

## POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION REGULATIONS

**Section 1.** Chapter 639 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

- 1. Before dispensing a controlled substance prescription, an employee of a pharmacy must obtain and review the picture identification of the patient or his agent receiving the prescription, except where:
  - (a) The prescription will be paid for in whole or in part by a third-party insurer; or
- (b) The prescription is for a patient who has had prescriptions for the controlled substance previously filled at the pharmacy.
  - (c) The pharmacy is part of a health care facility or clinic where the patient is being treated.
  - 2. An employee of a pharmacy shall not dispense the prescription if:
- (a) The person presenting or receiving the prescription does not produce a current picture identification issued by a federal, state, or local governmental agency; or
- (b) The person reviewing the identification reasonably believes that the identification produced by the person presenting or receiving the prescription is false, invalid, or altered.
  - 3. The person reviewing the identification shall record his review of the identification by:
- (a) Making a photocopy of the identification that is kept with the copy of the prescription; or
- (b) Recording the full name and identification number of the person receiving the prescription on the prescription, the refill log, the counseling log, or any other readily retrievable document or within a computer record related to the patient.
