A REGULATION relating to telecommunication service; revising the provisions governing lifeline discounts offered by certain telecommunications carriers to qualifying low-income subscribers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 704.680475 is hereby amended to read as follows:

704.680475 1. An eligible telecommunications carrier shall offer to subscribers within its service area the following services:

- (a) Lifeline; and
- (b) Link up.
- 2. In offering lifeline service pursuant to subsection 1, an eligible telecommunications carrier shall offer to qualifying low-income subscribers [a lifeline discount of at least \$5.25 per line per month, but the discount must not exceed 60 percent of the amount of the monthly rate charged by the carrier for one-party residential basic local exchange service, including, without limitation, the charge for a federal subscriber line.] such lifeline discounts as are necessary to enable the carrier to comply fully with the directives of the Federal Communications

 Commission, including, without limitation, 47 C.F.R. § 54.403.
 - 3. As used in this section, "link up" has the meaning ascribed to it in 47 C.F.R. § 54.411(a).
