AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 449.037.

A REGULATION relating to medical facilities; eliminating the requirement that a facility for skilled nursing must provide proof of coverage for liability when it submits its application for the renewal of its license; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 449.74411 is hereby amended to read as follows:

449.74411 1. A facility for skilled nursing must be operated and conducted in the name designated on the license for the facility, with the name of the person responsible for its operation also appearing on the face of the license. The license is not transferable.

- 2. A facility for skilled nursing shall not admit more patients to the facility than the number of beds for which it is licensed, except in emergencies. A facility that admits more patients to the facility than the number of beds for which it is licensed shall immediately notify the Bureau of the additional admissions.
 - 3. A facility for skilled nursing shall :
- (a) Retain retain proof that it is adequately covered against liabilities resulting from claims incurred in the course of its operation. F; and
- (b) Verify the coverage at the time it submits its annual application for the renewal of its license.
