PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS OF NEVADA

Utilization of laser radiation in the performance of the practice of dentistry or dental hygiene.

New section to read:

Within 1 year of the effective date of this regulation, each licensee who uses or wishes to use laser radiation in his practice of dentistry or dental hygiene must include with his application for annual renewal of his license proof that he is certified in the use of a laser, approved by the FDA, having successfully completed a laser proficiency course of at least 6 hours that utilizes the Curriculum Guidelines and Standards for Dental Laser Education as recognized by the Academy of Laser Dentistry.

NAC 631.030: Provision of certain information and documentation by applicant for licensure; examination for certain licenses (NRS 631.190; 631.220; 631.250; 631.255; 631.272; 631.273; 631.274; 631.275)

Section (2) (b) If applicable, the proof required by subsection 5;

(5) An applicant for licensure who wishes to use laser radiation in his practice of dentistry or dental hygiene must provide to the Board proof that he has successfully completed a laser proficiency course of at least 6 hours that utilizes the Curriculum Guidelines and Standards for Dental Laser Education as recognized by the Academy of Laser Dentistry.

NAC 631.210 (2)(f): Duties delegable to a dental hygienist

Section 2(f): Apply and activate agents for bleaching teeth with a light source

- (g) Use a laser that has been approved by the Food and Drug Administration to perform intrasulcular periodontal procedures or tooth whitening procedures if:
 - (1) The use of such a laser for those purposes is within the scope of the education, experience, and training of the dental hygienist;
 - (2) Before operating the laser, the dental hygienist has provided proof to the dentist that the dental hygienist has successfully completed a laser proficiency course of at least 6 hours that utilizes the Curriculum Guidelines and Standards for Dental Laser Education as recognized by the Academy of Laser Dentistry; and
 - (3) The supervising dentist has successfully completed a laser proficiency course of at least 6 hours that utilizes the Curriculum Guidelines and Standards for Dental Laser Education as recognized by the Academy of Laser Dentistry.
