AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 391.019.

A REGULATION relating to educational personnel; revising the provisions governing an endorsement to teach drivers' education; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 391.225 is hereby amended to read as follows:

391.225 To receive an endorsement authorizing the teaching of a course in drivers' education, a person must:

- 1. Hold a bachelor's degree;
- 2. Hold a *valid* secondary *or special* license [;] to teach, excluding a business and industry endorsement; and
- 3. Have completed 3 semester hours of credit in basic concepts of drivers' education and traffic safety from an accredited college or university.
