AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 679B.130 and 687B.450 (section 1 of chapter 90, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 249).

A REGULATION relating to insurance; requiring certain medical examinations to follow a standard set of criteria; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

- **Section 1.** Chapter 687B of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. Any medical examination required by an insurer pursuant to NRS 687B.450 (section 1 of chapter 90, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 249) must follow a standard set of criteria established by the insurer for the medical examination. The standard set of criteria for the medical examination must be consistently applied to each insured.
- 2. As used in this section, "medical examination" means an examination completed by a licensed physician, including, without limitation, a physical, laboratory tests, radiology or imaging tests, completion of a medical history questionnaire, the taking of physical measurements, including, without limitation, height, weight or blood pressure, or an examination of the heart or other bodily systems or organs.
