PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

COMMISSION GENERAL REGULATION No. 351

A REGULATION to establish provisions for a 1-day group fishing permit pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 25 of Assembly Bill No. 573.

Section 1. Chapter 502 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

- 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, a 1-day group fishing permit issued as provided in chapter 502 of NRS and this chapter authorizes a person that is a member of the group to whom it is issued to fish only on the date of validity specified on the permit.
- 2. If no date of validity is specified on the 1-day group fishing permit, then the date of issuance of the permit will be deemed the date of validity for the permit.
- 3. The name of the designated primary adult of the group and, if he has one, either the number of his valid annual fishing license or 1-day permit to fish, or the authorization number for such a document and the total number of members of the group will be displayed on the face of each 1-day group fishing permit issued to each member of the group.
- 4. Persons must not be added to a group permit once the transaction for the 1-day group fishing permit is complete.
- 5. The Department may issue a 1-day group permit in the form of an authorization number in lieu of a document. Such a permit or authorization number may be used only:
 - (a) By the person to whom it is issued; and
 - (b) On the date of validity.

A person using such a permit must, upon the request of a law enforcement officer, specify the authorization number, the name and fishing license or permit number of the designated primary adult for the group and present proof of his identity.
