PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

NAC 630.___ Special event license for visiting physicians conducting demonstrations (NRS 630.047; NRS 630.130; NRS 630. 261 (1) (b); NRS 630.268)

- 1. The Board may grant a special event limited license to out of state licensed physicians who come to Nevada for a short period of time to conduct demonstrations of techniques, procedures, devices or cosmetic substances, including botox, under the following conditions:
 - a. No later than 30 days prior to the event, the physician must have completed and furnish to the Board an appropriate, abbreviated application form approved by the board for such limited purposes,
 - b. No later than 14 days prior to the event, the physician must provide verification to the Board that he is currently licensed, legally permitted to practice, and is in good standing in the state in which he practices,
 - c. No later than 14 days prior to the event, the physician must provide the Board with a letter from a physician licensed in Nevada, who agrees to be present during all procedures and to accept liability for the demonstrations or procedures, along with a copy of that physician's current medical practice insurance policy,
 - d. No later than 14 days prior to the event, the physician must provide the Board with the dates, times and places of the demonstrations or procedures,
 - e. The physician must provide to the Board, prior to any demonstrations or procedures, the full name and address of the patient, name of the procedure(s) to be performed, a copy of a duly signed consent form for each person the physician intends to use for purposes of demonstration or procedure, and a written history and physical examination for each such patient.
 - f. Procedures are to be performed for demonstration purposes only, and no fee or compensation may be paid to the physician, directly or indirectly, nor should there be any expectation of such payment of fees or compensation,
 - g. No later than 14 days prior to the event, the physician must agree in writing to be subject to all of the terms and conditions of the Nevada Medical Practice Act (NRS Chapter 630 and NAC Chapter 630) and be subject to the jurisdiction of the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners for any disciplinary action arising under the terms of this regulation,

- h. The physician's application must be accompanied by a fee of \$300.00 for the special event limited license, and
- i. A wallet card id shall be issued, with the dates of validity, which shall be a term of not more than 15 consecutive days.
- 2. For purposes of this regulation, "No later than ___ days prior to the event" means the required materials are to be tendered to the licensing department of the Board. Required licensure materials which are received inside the stated time requirements are subject to rejection and may result in denial of limited licensure.
