## PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

**Explanation:** Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets  $\[ \]$  is material to be omitted.

**AUTHORITY:** NRS 385.080 & 385.110

NAC <u>389</u> is hereby amended as follows:

New Section - NAC 389.XXX - Foods and Nutrition. A course of study in Foods and Nutrition must include instruction designed to teach the pupil to do the following:

- 1. Examine factors that influence food choices.
- 2. Evaluate the nutritional needs of individuals and families in relation to health and wellness.
  - 3. Integrate knowledge, skills and practices in sanitation and safety.
  - 4. Employ kitchen resource management.
  - 5. Apply knowledge, skills and techniques used in food preparation.
  - 6. Employ the principles of meal management.
  - 7. Make informed consumer choices.
  - 8. Analyze career paths within the food and nutrition industry.
- 9. Achieve competence in workplace readiness, career development, and lifelong learning.

NAC 389.576 [Textiles and Clothing] Fashion, Textiles and Design (NRS 385.080, 385.110) [A course of study in textiles and clothing must include instruction designed to teach the pupil to do the following:

- 1. Identify and describe trends in fashion of the past, present and future.
- 2. Identify and describe appropriate construction of a commercially produced garment or piece of furniture.
  - 3. Develop the skills used in the display, advertising and sale of merchandise.
- 4. Identify the procedures for opening and operating a business involving clothing or furnishings.
- 5. Identify state or national standards and requirements for licensing, operating or working in a business involving clothing or furnishings.]

A course of study in Fashion, Textiles and Design must include instruction designed to teach the pupil to do the following:

- 1. Examine skills needed to effectively manage clothing decisions.
  - 2. Integrate knowledge, skills and practices in clothing and textile construction.
  - 3. Evaluate the use, care and production of fibers, fabrics and textiles.
  - 4. Develop knowledge and skills needed for the field of fashion merchandising.
  - 5. Analyze career paths within the fashion, textile and design fields.
  - 6. Achieve competence in workplace readiness, career development and lifelong learning.

NAC 389.582 [Interior design] Housing and Interior Design (NRS 385.080, 385.110) [A course of study in interior design must include instruction designed to teach the pupil to do the following:

- 1. Demonstrate the knowledge necessary to obtain employment in interior design.
- 2. Identify the quality of the construction of furnishings and accessories.
- 3. Select and merchandise furnishings, appliances and equipment to meet the needs of the consumer and to make a profit.
  - 4. Identify the procedures for opening and operating a business involving interior design.
  - 5. Identify state or national standards for licensing of a business of interior design.]

A course of study in Housing and Interior Design must include instruction designed to teach the pupil to do the following:

- 1. Analyze career paths within the housing and interior design fields.
- 2. Evaluate housing needs and wants.
- 3. Investigate options in selecting a place to live.
- 4. Evaluate housing for quality construction.
- 5. Describe architectural features of a house.
- 6. Demonstrate space-planning skills.
- 7. Evaluate and select home furnishings.
- 8. Evaluate and select backgrounds for home interiors.
- 9. Complete an interior design plan.
- 10. Achieve competence in workplace readiness, career development and lifelong learning.
