

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD OF
ARCHITECTURE, INTERIOR DESIGN AND RESIDENTIAL DESIGN**

NAC 623.0185 is hereby amended to read as follows:

NAC 623.0185 “Responsible control” defined. (NRS 623.140) “Responsible control” ~~[means the amount of control over and detailed knowledge of the content of a technical submission during its preparation that is ordinarily exercised by a registered architect, registered interior designer or residential designer, as applicable, when applying the normal standard of professional care.]~~ *shall mean the amount of control a registrant is required to maintain over decisions made while exercising supervisory direction and authority.*

A registrant who signs and seals documents in “responsible control” must be capable of answering questions as to the decisions made during the registrant’s work on the project in sufficient detail as to leave little doubt as to the registrant’s proficiency for the work performed.

The registrant should be able to define the amount of control and how it was exercised and be able to demonstrate, through documentation, that the registrant was answerable within said amount of control necessary for the work done.

Additionally, the registrant must be able to judge the validity and applicability of recommendations prior to their incorporation into the work, including the qualifications of those making the recommendations.
