NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON A REGULATION

**Notice of Hearing for the Amendment of Regulations of the Nevada State Board of
Cosmetology**

The Nevada State Board of Cosmetology will hold a public hearing at 9:00 a.m., on May 5, 2008, at 1785 E. Sahara Ave., Suite 255, Las Vegas, Nevada. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the amendment of regulations that pertain to chapter 644 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

1. The need for and the purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment.

To protect the health and safety of the public by clear identification of one-time use only disposable items.

2. Either the terms or the substance of the regulations to be adopted, amended or repealed, or a description of the subjects and issues involved.

Clear identification of one-time use only disposable items.

3. The estimated economic effect of the regulation on the business which it is to regulate and on the public. These must be stated separately and in each case must include:

- (a) Both adverse and beneficial effects; and
- (b) Both immediate and long-term effects.

Economic Effect on Business-

Adverse effect: The cost of providing nail and pedicure services to the clients of manicurists will be increased. The increase in cost per customer is estimated to be approximately \$4.00 per customer.

Beneficial effect: The exposure for the transfer of infection is significantly reduced by the use of one-time only disposable items in doing services on the customers. The amendment to NAC 644.340 adds certain tools and implements that can only be used by one person.

Immediate effect is an increase in cost of supplies for manicurists. However, the long-term effect is that the manicurist will ultimately pass-on the cost to the customer. The long-term economic effect will be the reduction in the liability exposure of manicurists due to issues of accidental transfer of a fungus or infection to their customers and increased safety for their customers.

Economic Effect on the Public-

Adverse effect: A small increase in cost for nail and pedicure services for customers of manicurists.

Beneficial effect: Higher levels of protection from infection for the customer receiving nails and pedicure services.

Immediate and long-term effect: Increased health safety.

4. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the proposed regulation.

Proposed regulation adds no additional cost to the agency.

5. A description of and citation to any regulations of other state or local governmental agencies which the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates and a statement explaining why the duplication or overlapping is necessary. If the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates a federal regulation, the notice must include the name of the regulating federal agency.

This regulation does not overlap or duplicate any other state, local or federal regulation.

6. If the regulation is required pursuant to federal law, a citation and description of the federal law.

The regulation is not required pursuant to federal law.

7. If the regulation includes provisions which are more stringent than a federal regulation that regulates the same activity, a summary of such provisions.

Not applicable.

8. Whether the proposed regulation establishes a new fee or increases an existing fee.

The proposed regulation does not apply new fees.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology. Written submissions must be received by the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology on or before May 1, 2008. If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

A copy of this notice and the regulations to be amended will be on file at the State Library, 100 Stewart Street, Carson City, Nevada, for inspection by members of the public during business hours. Additional copies of the notice and the regulation to be amended will be available at the Nevada State Board of Cosmetology at 1785 E. Sahara Ave., Suite 255, Las Vegas, Nevada and 4600 Kietzke Lane, Building K, Suite 221, Reno, Nevada, and in all counties in which an office of the agency is not maintained, at the main public library, for inspection and copying by members of the public during business hours. This notice and the text of the proposed regulation are also available in the State of Nevada Register of Administrative Regulations, which is prepared and published monthly by the Legislative Counsel Bureau pursuant to NRS 233B.0653, and on the Internet at <http://www.leg.state.nv.us>. Copies of this notice and the proposed regulation will also be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies if it is deemed necessary.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, will issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.
