The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulations. Please submit any written comments no later than **May 29, 2012**.

<u>LCB File No. R026-12</u>. Amend NAC 686A.282, 686A.288 and 686A.302. Repeal NAC 686A.292, 686A.294, 686A.296, 686A.298, 686A.300 and 689A.431.

A regulation relating to insurance; prescribing the form which must be used for the submission of certain claims; repealing certain provisions relating to the submission of certain information for an insurance claim; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

LCB File No. R027-12. Amend NAC 686A.4775, 686A.563 and 686A.573.

A regulation relating to insurance; revising provisions governing an illustration actuary; revising the notice that must be provided with policies of life insurance and annuity contracts that replace existing policies and contracts to conform with statutory requirements; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON REGULATION

Notice of Hearing for the Adoption, Amendment or Repeal of Regulations of The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance

The State of Nevada, Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance ("Division"), (775) 687-0700, will hold a public hearing at **9:30 a.m. on June 14, 2012,** at the Division's office located at 1818 East College Parkway, 1st floor hearing room, Carson City, Nevada 89706. Interested persons may also participate through a simultaneous videoconference conducted at the Bradley Building, 2501 East Sahara Avenue, 2nd floor conference room, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the amendment of a regulation that pertains to **chapter 679B** of the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC").

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of Nevada Revised Statute ("NRS") 233B.0603 and the directives of the Governor:

LCB File No. R028-12. Confidentiality of Records During an Examination.

A regulation relating to insurance; removing obsolete references to the Advocate for Insurance Customers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

(1) Why is the regulation necessary and what is its purpose?

The proposed regulation amends that portion of NAC 679B.034 which is now obsolete. By eliminating the reference to the Advocate in this regulation, the regulation will be current.

When information is gathered by the Commissioner as a result of an examination, this regulation defined what information is confidential and not available for the public. The regulation prescribed that, after the completion of an examination, the information is confidential unless "(II) The Advocate for Insurance Customers requests release of the records and other information for public inspection." The position of Advocate for Insurance Customers ("Advocate") was created by Senate Bill 474 in the 1991 session of the Legislature. This position was repealed during the 1993 session.

(2) What are the terms or substance of the proposed regulation?

The proposed regulation amends that portion of NAC 679B.034 which is now obsolete. By removing the reference to the Advocate, the regulation will be current.

(3) What is the anticipated impact of the regulation on the problem(s)?

Since the subsection of the regulation regarding the Advocate has been obsolete for more than 18 years, there will be no impact. This amendment is for housekeeping purposes only.
