Purpose of the rule: To streamline regulations governing interconnection agreements for telecommunication service that are duplicative of Federal Law.

Statutory Authority: NRS 703.025 and 704.210.

Type of Regulation: Permanent Regulation

Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [omitted material] is to be omitted.

**Section 1.** Chapter 703 of the NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 of this regulation:

- Sec. 2. 1. The Commission hereby adopts by reference the laws contained in 47 U.S.C. Parts 251 and 252, in the form most recently adopted, unless the Commission gives notice that the most recent revision is not suitable for this State pursuant to subsection 2. Copies of those parts are available at no charge from the United States Government Printing Office at the Internet address http://www.gpoaccess.gov.
- 2. If any section adopted by reference pursuant to subsection 1 is revised, the Commission may review the revision to ensure its suitability for this State. If the Commission determines that the revision is not suitable for this State, the Commission will hold a public hearing to review its determination within 6 months after the date of publication of the revision and give notice of that hearing. If, after the hearing, the Commission does not revise

its determination, the Commission will give notice within 30 days after the hearing that the revision is not suitable for this State. If the Commission does not give such notice, the revision becomes part of the regulation adopted by reference pursuant to subsection 1.
