A REGULATION relating to vehicle emissions; specifying the length of time that an evidence of compliance must be valid for registration purposes;

Section 1. A new section is hereby added to NAC Chapter 445B as follows:

1. An evidence of compliance as defined in NRS 445B.730 is valid for a period of 90 days upon the date of issuance by an authorized inspection station or authorized station.

Section 2. A new section is hereby added to NAC Chapter 445B as follows:

1. If an evidence of compliance is issued for registration purposes in accordance with the sale of a vehicle as prescribed in subsection two of NRS 445B.800, the evidence of compliance must remain valid until the temporary placard issued pursuant to subsection four of NRS
