## SECOND REVISED PROPOSED REGULATION OF

## THE BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

## LCB File No. R155-12

EXPLANATION - Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 501.105, 501.181 and 503.655.

A REGULATION relating to shed antlers; prohibiting a person from collecting shed antlers under certain circumstances; providing an exception; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law requires the Board of Wildlife Commissioners to adopt regulations for the taking of shed antlers. "Shed antlers" means any antlers which have been naturally shed by any big game animal in this State. (NRS 503.655) This regulation prohibits, with certain exceptions, a person from collecting shed antlers at any time during the year unless the shed antlers are collected by the person from the field from April 15 to December 31, inclusive, of that year. A person is exempted from this prohibition on collecting shed antlers if the shed antlers are located on private property and the person is: (1) the owner of the property; (2) related within the first degree of consanguinity or affinity to the owner of the property; or (3) an employee of the owner of the property who has been authorized by the owner of the property to collect shed antlers on the property.

- **Section 1.** Chapter 503 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person shall not collect shed antlers at any time during the year unless the shed antlers are collected by the person from the field from April 15 to December 31, inclusive, of that year.
- 2. A person may collect shed antlers located on private property at any time during the year from private property if the person is:

- (a) The owner of the property;
- (b) Related to the owner of the property within the first degree of consanguinity or affinity; or
- (c) An employee of the owner of the property who has been authorized by the owner of the property to collect shed antlers on the property.
