NAC 391.320 Endorsement to serve as social worker. (NRS 385.080, 391.019)

- 1. To receive an endorsement to serve as a social worker, a person must:
- (a) Hold a current license issued by the Board of Examiners for Social Workers; and
- (b) Have completed an educational program for social workers in schools which includes a practicum in school.
- 2. In addition to the requirements listed in subsection 1, a person who wishes to receive such an endorsement must:
 - (a) Have completed a program to serve as a social worker in schools that is approved by the Board;
 - (b) Hold the credential issued by the National Association of Social Workers certifying that the holder is a specialist in social worker in schools; or
 - (c) Hold a master's degree in social work from a college or university that has been accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.
 - 3. To renew the endorsement, the holder must:
 - (a) [Have completed at least 6 semester hours in education relating to social work in schools or an equal amount of credit for in-service work relating to social work in schools; and] [(b)] Continue to hold a valid license issued by the Board of Examiners for Social Workers[.] and
 - (b) Each time that license is renewed by the Nevada State Board of Examiners for Social Workers, provide a copy of the license to the Teacher Licensure Office of the Nevada Department of Education.
