## PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

## LCB File No. R069-14

NAC 386.355 Apportionment from State Distributive School Account: Count day; prerequisite to receive apportionments. (NRS 386.540, 386.570)

- 1. **Except as stated in subsection 2,** The count day for a charter school is the same as the count day for the school district in which the charter school is located and is the last day of the first school month of that school district.
- 2. A charter school that is sponsored by the SPCSA and uses distance education as its primary method of instruction may use as its county of location: either that county in which the office is physically located, or that county in which the majority of the school's pupils reside. The charter school must declare either upon the effective date of this regulation, or the establishment of the school, which county of location will be used. This selection will determine the county location for school calendar and county day procedures and reporting. This declaration must be sent to the Superintendent of Public Instruction.
- 2. To receive apportionments from the State Distributive School Account, a charter school must have pupils enrolled and attending school and account for at least 20 school days in the first school month, which may include days on which class is not in session, including, without limitation, in-service days and conference days for teachers.
- 3. If an individual pupil is enrolled and attending a charter school at least 1 school day before the count day, that pupil will be counted.
