Proposed Regulations of the Department of Motor Vehicles, LCB File No R058-15

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

- 1. The need for and the purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment.
 - Section 2 Plate Reissue (AB484, 2015)
 - 1. Plates to be reissued every 8 years.
 - 4. Discontinued plates to be reissued.
 - 5. Notification of reissuance to registered owners.
 - 6. The notification will include the plate cost recovery fee.
 - Section 3 Temporary Dealer Placard
 - 1. Placement of Placard
 - 2. Use of Synthetic paper with a thickness of at least 7 mils.
 - Section 4 Deletes the requirement for color copies when issuing Short-term Lessor Permits.
 - Section 5 Increases the Plate Cost Recovery Fee from \$3 to \$3.50 per plate.
 - Section 6 NAC 482.9005:
 - 1. Clarifies that the fee for a VIN inspection is \$1.
 - 2. Establishes the fee of \$1 for a moped inspection. The fee must be established in regulations pursuant to SB404, 2015.

Repealed Sections: NAC 482.284, 482.288

These are Taxation provisions regarding short-term lessors that are no longer needed.

 - The proposed regulation establishes a new fee of \$1 for the inspection of a moped as provided in statute (Section 1 of Senate Bill No. 404, chapter 326, Statutes of Nevada 2015, at page 1745).
 - The proposed regulation increases the Plate Cost Recovery Fee from \$3 to \$3.50 per license plate (NAC 482.295).

If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Department of Motor Vehicles may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

Additional copies of the notice and regulations to be adopted will be available at each of the Department of Motor Vehicles listed, and at the main public libraries listed, for inspection and copying by members of the public during business hours. This notice and the text of the proposed regulation are also available in the State of Nevada Register of Administrative Regulations, which is prepared and published monthly by the Legislative Counsel Bureau pursuant to NRS 233B.0653, and on the Internet at http://leg.state.nv.us/Register/. Copies of this notice and the proposed regulation will also be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies if it is deemed necessary.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter will issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.
