

**LEGISLATIVE REVIEW OF ADOPTED REGULATIONS—NRS 233B.066**  
**Informational Statement**  
**LCB File No. R108-15**

**1. A clear and concise explanation of the need for the adopted regulation:**

AB448, codified in NRS 388B, requires the Department to draft regulations. Specifically, it is required that the Department establish criteria by regulation to determine when pupil achievement and school performance at a school is unsatisfactory (NRS 388B.200(1)(c)), the process for a charter operator to apply (NRS 388B.210(2)), and any regulations necessary or convenient to carry out the provisions of NRS 388B (NRS388B.060).

The regulations clarify certain things not specifically spelled out in the law, such as the timeline and process for selecting schools that are eligible for conversion, how the operators will be selected, how students will be enrolled if more students apply than are seats available, and who is responsible for building maintenance.
