PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

Proposed Regulation Language (DRAFT):

Pursuant to NRS 353.2753, the Division proposes the following regulation:

Section 1: Chapter 353 of the NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

- 1. The Division shall conduct an assessment upon the request of a local government to determine whether the events constitute a disaster and to assess damages.
- 2. The Division shall draft a report of damages, which shall include the following information:
 - a) A description of the event resulting in damages, including, but not limited to:
 - 1) Location and Counties affected,
 - 2) Resources requested and utilized, and
 - 3) Declarations requested and signed.
 - b) Estimated damage totals.
 - c) A description of the damages to public infrastructure, including information related to:
 - 1) Debris removal,
 - 2) Emergency protection measures,
 - 3) Roads and bridges,
 - 4) Water control facilities,
 - 5) Public buildings and equipment,
 - 6) Utilities, and
 - 7) Recreation.
 - d) A description of the damages to affected homes and businesses.
 - e) A description of other assistance requested and received.
 - f) The purpose of proposed project, including, but not limited to:
 - 1) Repair,
 - 2) Replacement,
 - 3) Emergency Response, and
 - 4) Mitigation.
