Proposed Regulations for the Nevada Intrastate Mutual Aid System Intrastate Mutual Aid Committee Approved on June 14, 2016

Section 1) The Nevada Division of Emergency Management (NDEM) shall develop policies and procedures, with input from the Nevada Intrastate Mutual Aid Committee (IMAC), regarding coordinating responses to resource requests from other states through the Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC). The policies and procedures shall include, without limitation, the following items:

- a. Receiving requests for EMAC assistance;
- b. Training and exercise requirement for participants in EMAC assistance;
- c. Deploying in support of an EMAC request; and,
- d. Redeploying to Nevada following supporting an EMAC request.

Section 2) The Division shall report on the Intrastate Mutual Aid System as follows:

- a. By June 30 of each year, NDEM shall ensure the statewide distribution of a report to the IMAC containing, without limitation, the following information:
 - i. Information regarding declared emergencies and disasters within Nevada during the previous fiscal year, including overviews of any after action reports conducted following an event;
 - ii. Information regarding non-declared emergencies and disasters monitored by the Nevada Division of Emergency Management within Nevada during the previous fiscal year;
 - iii. Resources requested within Nevada through the Intrastate Mutual Aid System during the previous fiscal year, the status of those requests, and an update on the status of the reimbursement process for the requests in a financial report;
 - iv. Fulfilled resource requests from other states through the EMAC during the previous fiscal year and the status of those requests; and,
 - v. Information regarding and status of Nevada's emergency response inventory for the previous fiscal year.
- b. By September 30 of each year, the IMAC shall:
 - i. Review policies and procedures for administering the Nevada Intrastate Mutual Aid System; and,

- ii. Make recommendations for improvements for administering the Nevada Intrastate Mutual Aid System to the Chief of the Nevada Division of Emergency Management.
- c. By January 1 of each year, NDEM shall coordinate with county and tribal emergency managers to identify the current status of participation in the Intrastate Mutual Aid System and conduct outreach regarding updates to policies and procedures as recommended by the IMAC.
