Notice of Workshop to Solicit Comments on Proposed Regulation

The Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners, located at 1105 Terminal Way, Suite 301, Reno, Nevada 89502, is proposing to amend Chapter 630 of the NAC to include a new section relating to disciplinary action. The public workshop will be conducted on **Wednesday**, **January 3**, **2018**, **at 11:00 a.m.**, at the Nevada State Board of Dental Examiners located at 6010 S. Rainbow Blvd., Bldg. A, Suite 1, Las Vegas, Nevada 89118, and video conferenced to the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners located at 1105 Terminal Way, Suite 301, Reno, Nevada 89502. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulation:

R100-17 - A Regulation relating to prescriptions for controlled substances; establishing the disciplinary action to be imposed upon a licensee for the issuance of a fraudulent, illegal, unauthorized or otherwise inappropriate prescription for a controlled substance listed in schedule II, III or IV; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
