AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 501.105, 501.181 and 503.655.

A REGULATION relating to shed antlers; prohibiting a person from collecting shed antlers under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law requires the Board of Wildlife Commissioners to adopt regulations for the taking of shed antlers. "Shed antlers" means any antlers which have been naturally shed by any big game animal in this State. (NRS 503.655) This regulation prohibits a person from collecting shed antlers at any time during a year unless the shed antlers are collected by the person from the field from April 15 to December 31, inclusive, of that year.

- **Section 1.** Chapter 503 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
 - 1. A person shall not take or gather shed antlers from or on public lands in Elko,

 Eureka, Lander, Lincoln, Nye and White Pine Counties:
 - a. At any time during a year from January 1 to March 31, inclusive, of that year.
 - b. Unless it is between the hours of 10am and sunset during the period of April 1 to May 31, inclusive, of that year.
