AUTHORITY: NRS 481.051, 482.160, 482.268

A REGULATION relating to motor vehicles; providing for the implementation of bonded titles; adjusting the fee imposed to defray the cost of producing license plates; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. Chapter 482 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2, 3, and 4 of this regulation.

Sec. 2. 1. A person who is not a dealer, manufacturer, rebuilder, salvage pool, wrecker, body shop or garage operator may apply for a title pursuant to Senate Bill 452 of the 79th Session and must:

- (a) Provide satisfactory proof of residence as defined in NRS 482.103; and
- (b) Provide photographic views of the:
 - (1) Left hand side of the vehicle;
 - (2) Right hand side of the vehicle;
 - (3) Front of the vehicle; and
 - (4) Rear of the vehicle.

Sec. 3. The Department will base the security amount for a bonded vehicle title on the original Manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) of the vehicle.

Sec. 4. 1. The Department will not issue a bonded title for a vehicle that:

- (a) Has been designated at any time by any jurisdiction, insurance company or owner to be;
 - (1) Non-repairable;
 - (2) Non-rebuildable;
 - (3) Junk;

- (4) Damaged, wrecked or burned resulting in the residual value only being for parts or scrap metal; or
- (5) Designated unfit for further use in accordance with the original purpose for which it as constructed.
- (b) Has been designated by any jurisdiction, insurance company, or owner to be for export only.
- (c) Was not manufactured for sale in the United States unless accompanied by importation documents required for standard titles; or
- (d) Was originally manufactured as an Off-Highway or Off-Road use only vehicle.
- **Sec. 5.** NAC 482.295 is hereby amended to read as follows: 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, each person who applies for a license plate for a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer must pay a fee [of \$3.50] not to exceed \$3.00 to the Department pursuant to paragraph (b) of subsection 1 of NRS 482.268 to defray the cost of producing the license plate.
- 2. A person is not required to pay the fee pursuant to subsection 1 if the cost of producing the license plate is otherwise charged pursuant to chapter 482 of NRS or any regulations adopted pursuant thereto.
- **Sec. 6.** NAC 482.295 is hereby amended to read as follows: 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, each person who applies for a license plate for a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer must pay a fee [of \$3.50] not to exceed \$3.00 to the Department pursuant to paragraph (b) of subsection 1 of NRS 482.268 to defray the cost of producing the license plate.
- 2. A person is not required to pay the fee pursuant to subsection 1 if the cost of producing the license plate is otherwise charged pursuant to chapter 482 of NRS or any regulations adopted pursuant thereto.
- **Sec. 7.** Chapter 487 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 8, 9, and 10 of this regulation.
- **Sec. 8.** 1. A person who is not a dealer, manufacturer, rebuilder, salvage pool, wrecker, body shop or garage operator may apply for a title pursuant to Senate Bill 452 of the 79th Session and must:
- (a) Provide satisfactory proof of residence as defined in NRS 482.103; and
- (b) Provide photographic views of the:
 - (1) Left hand side of the vehicle;
 - (2) Right hand side of the vehicle;
 - (3) Front of the vehicle; and
 - (4) Rear of the vehicle.

Sec. 9. The Department will base the security amount for a bonded vehicle title on the original Manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) of the vehicle.

Sec. 10. *1. The Department will not issue a bonded title for a vehicle that:*

- (a) Has been designated at any time by any jurisdiction, insurance company or owner to be;
 - (1) Non-repairable;
 - (2) Non-rebuildable;
 - (3) *Junk*;
- (4) Damaged, wrecked or burned resulting in the residual value only being for parts or scrap metal; or
- (5) Designated unfit for further use in accordance with the original purpose for which it as constructed.
- (b) Has been designated by any jurisdiction, insurance company, or owner to be for export only.
- (c) Was not manufactured for sale in the United States unless accompanied by importation documents required for standard titles; or
- (d) Was originally manufactured as an Off-Highway or Off-Road use only vehicle.

Sec. 11. *1. This section becomes effective upon approval by the Legislative Commission.*

- 2. Sections 1 to 5 and 7 to 10, inclusive, of this regulation become effective on July 1, 2018.
- 3. Section 6 of this regulation becomes effective on April 1, 2018.
