PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE NEVADA BOARD OF PODIATRY

NAC 635.365 Continuing education: Retention and submission of certificate of completion.

A REGULATION relating to continuing education requirements for renewal of licensure.

Section 1. NAC 635.365 is here by amended as follows:

635.365 **A** podiatrist shall:

1. Retain a certificate of completion received for completing a course of study or training to satisfy the requirement of continuing education pursuant to <u>NRS 635.115</u> for not less than 4

years after completing the course or training; and

2. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 635.115, submit a copy of the certificate to the

Board as the proof of completion of the hours of continuing education required for renewal of a license pursuant to NRS 635.110. and

3.At least 2 hours of the continuing education must relate to the misuse and abuse of controlled substances, the prescribing of opioids, or addiction for each period of licensure.
