The following document is the initial draft regulation proposed by the agency submitted on 05/21/2018

## NAC 391.391 Endorsement to teach pupils in program of orientation and mobility. (NRS 391.019)

- 1. To receive an endorsement to teach pupils in a program of orientation and mobility, a person must hold a:
  - (a) Hold a bachelor's or graduate degree in:
    - (1) Orientation and mobility; or
- (2) Any other field of study and have successfully completed an orientation and mobility program at a university approved by the Association for Education and Rehabilitation of the Blind and Visually Impaired; or
- (b) Professional certificate in orientation and mobility issued by the Association for Education and Rehabilitation of the Blind and Visually Impaired. Submit transcripts showing a bachelor's or higher degree in orientation and mobility conferred by a regionally accredited college or university, and hold a specialty credential as a Certified Orientation and Mobility Specialist from the Academy for Certification of Vision Rehabilitation and Education Professionals.
  - 2. Such an endorsement is not required to teach pupils in a program of orientation and mobility. (Added to NAC by Comm'n on Prof. Standards in Education by R094-99, eff. 11-2-99)
