A REGULATION relating to qualifications of a hearing officer.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law.....

Section 1. Chapter 624 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

NAC 624.xxx Hearing officer: Qualifications. (NRS 624.140, NRS 624.2545).

A person serving as a hearing officer pursuant to NRS 624.140 or NRS 624.2545 must be a licensed attorney in good standing in the State of Nevada and:

- 1. Have at least five years of experience as a licensed attorney preparing for, participating in, or reviewing formal hearings or trials involving civil litigation or administrative law at the federal, state, or local level; and
- 2. Have at least five years of experience as a licensed attorney in construction law, contractor licensing law, and bankruptcy law; or
- 3. Be a former state judge of general jurisdiction, a former federal magistrate, or federal judge.
