# LEGISLATIVE REVIEW OF ADOPTED REGULATIONS AS REQUIRED BY NRS 233B.066 LCB FILE No. R021-20

The following statement is submitted for adopted amendments to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 62B.

### 1. A clear and concise explanation of the need for the adopted regulation.

To create regulations that came from AB 472 (2017), which is a comprehensive Juvenile Justice Reform Bill, regarding the use of evidence-based programs and services by departments of juvenile probation, the Youth Parole Bureau, state facilities, and county youth camps (NRS 62B.615). In addition, juvenile justice data collection requirements were expanded, updated, and clarified (NRS 62H.200).

# 2. A description of how public comment was solicited, a summary of public response, and an explanation how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.

Copies of the proposed regulations, notices of workshop and notices of intent to act upon the regulation were sent by e-mail to persons who were known to have interest in the subject of procedures for the Division to verify that a public or private institution or agency to which a juvenile court commits a child, including, without limitation, a facility for the detention of children, as well as any persons who had specifically requested such notice.
