  - NRS 449.2418 "Unit" defined. This amendment to NAC 449 is drafted in order to ensure compliance with NRS 449.2418. Section 1 of Chapter 449 of NAC is amended by adding provisions set forth in Section 2: "Unit" means a component within a health care facility for providing patient care.
