AUTHORITY: NRS 639.070; NRS 639.100

A REGULATION relating to the locations where a pharmacist may practice pharmacy; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section. 1. NAC Chapter 639 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

NAC 639.XXX. Restrictions on Dispensing Compounded Drugs. Drugs compounded by a pharmacy, dispensing practitioner, or outsourcing facility cannot be dispensed, resold, supplied, or furnished by any entity other than the licensed entity that compounded the drug. Outsourcing facilities must have procedures to prohibit the dispensing of their compounded products by other entities. Drugs compounded by an outsourcing facility may be administered pursuant to an order of a practitioner.
