A REGULATION relating to the practice of pharmacy; revising provisions governing the requirements for, application for and registration as a registered pharmacist.

NAC 639.208 is hereby amended to read as follows:

For the purposes of paragraph (d) of subsection 1 of NRS 639.120, aAn applicant for a certificate as a registered pharmacist in this State by reciprocity pursuant to NRS 639.134, may provide evidence that they have met the requirements of paragraph (b) and (d) of subsection 1 of NRS 639.120 by completing the requirements of reciprocation by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP), Electronic Licensure Transfer Program (e-LTP). of must complete 1,740 hours of practical pharmaceutical experience as an intern pharmacist under the direct and immediate supervision of a registered pharmacist.
