PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

The following document is the initial draft regulation proposed by the agency submitted on 01/26/2022

NAC 387.12445

- 1. For the purpose of NRS 387.12445(9), "Administrative Expense" is defined as the salaries and benefits of General Administration employees plus the amount of Central Service expenses.
- 2. The maximum amount of money each school district may deduct from its adjusted base per pupil funding amount for administrative expenses is:
 - (a) A district with over 100,000 students: 5 percent;
 - (b) A district with over 7,501 students up to 100,000 students: 7.5 percent;
 - (c) A district with over 1,001 students up to 7,500 students: 10 percent;
 - (d) A district with 500 students up to 1,000 students: 15 percent; and
 - (e) A district with less than 500 students: 25 percent.
- 3. The following transactional coding, as documented in the Department's Chart of Accounts, will be used to determine the Administrative Expense under this regulation:
 - (a) General Administration, Function code 2300
 - (b) Central Services, Function code 2500
 - (c) Salaries, object codes 100
 - (d) Benefits, object code 200
