PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE NEVADA INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION

The following document is the initial draft regulation proposed by the agency submitted on 03/28/2022

NAC 385B.106 Composition; role; nonvoting membership; terms of nonvoting members. (NRS 385B.060)

- 1. The Board consists of [nine] <u>twelve</u> voting members selected from the administrative regions established pursuant to NAC 385B.104. The Board is the governing body of the Association.
- 2. In addition to the voting members specified in subsection 1, the Board includes the following nonvoting members:
 - (a) The president of:
 - (1) Each class established pursuant to NAC 385B.250;
 - (2) The private schools selected pursuant to NAC 385B.240; and
 - (3) The Nevada Athletic Directors Association or its successor organization;
- (b) A representative from Class [4A] <u>4A/5A</u> North who is not serving as a nonvoting member pursuant to subparagraph (1) of paragraph (a);
- (c) A representative from Class [4A] <u>4A/5A</u> South who is not serving as such a nonvoting member;
- (d) A representative appointed by the Nevada Association of School Administrators or its successor organization;
- (e) A representative appointed by an association of sports officials approved by the Association; [and]
 - (f) A representative from a charter school that is a member school : and
- <u>(g) Three pupils who are currently participating in a sanctioned sport of the Association to include:</u>
 - (1) One who is a resident of a county whose population is 700,000 or more;
 - (2) One who is a resident of a county whose population is 100,000 or more;
- (3) One who is a resident of a county whose population is less than 100,000; and each of whom is not the child of an employee of or an immediate family member of an employee of a school district, charter school or private school.
- 3. Each nonvoting member specified in subsection 2 serves for a term of 2 years. (Added to NAC by Nev. Interscholastic Activities Ass'n by R206-03, eff. 11-2-2004; A by R065-07, 1-30-2008; R207-08 & R147-10, 5-5-2011; R060-15 & R029-16, 6-28-2016) (Substituted in revision for NAC 386.628)

NAC 385B.108 Voting membership. (NRS 385B.060)

- 1. The voting membership of the Board is as follows:
- (a) Two representatives from Administrative Region I, which consists of Washoe County;
- (b) One representative from Administrative Region II, which consists of Carson City and Churchill and Douglas counties;
- (c) One representative from Administrative Region III, which consists of Elko, Esmeralda, Eureka, Humboldt, Lander, Lincoln, Lyon, Mineral, Nye, Pershing, Storey and White Pine counties; [and]

- (d) Five representatives from Administrative Region IV, which consists of Clark County..., and
- (e) Three representatives who are a parent or guardian of a pupil who participates in a sanctioned sport and include:
 - (1) One who is a resident of a county whose population is 700,000 or more;
 - (2) One who is a resident of a county whose population is 100,000 or more;
- (3) One who is a resident of a county whose population is less than 100,000; and none of whom are an employee of or an immediate family member of an employee of a school district, charter school or private school.
- 2. The President of the Board may vote on any item set forth on the agenda of the Board for which a vote is required.

NAC 385B.110 Selection of members; vacancies in membership; terms of voting members. (NRS 385B.060)

- 1. Each school trustee and each person who is:
- (a) A superintendent of a school district;
- (b) An assistant or deputy superintendent of a school district;
- (c) A director of athletics of a school district; [or]
- (d) A principal of a high school ; or
- (e) A parent or guardian of a pupil who participates in a sanctioned sport who is not an employee of or an immediate family member of an employee of a school district, charter school, or private school,
- is eligible to be selected to serve as a member of the Board.
- 2. The school trustees of each administrative region established pursuant to NAC 385B.104 shall select the members of the Board from that region. The term of a selected member begins on July 1 after his or her selection. A member of the Board may be reselected.
- 3. If a vacancy occurs in the membership of the Board, the Executive Director shall notify the school trustees of the administrative region from which the vacant member was selected. An unexpired term of a member of the Board must be filled by the school trustees of the administrative region in which the vacancy occurs. Each member selected to fill a vacancy serves for the remainder of the unexpired term.
- 4. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, each voting member of the Board serves for a term of 3 years.
