## **NAC 62H Revision**

New: Add to NAC 62H

- 1. Pursuant to NRS 62H/SB 366 (Dec 1<sup>st</sup> of each year), each department of juvenile services and the Youth Parole Bureau shall submit data and information, for the preceding 12 months, regarding any proceeding to determine the competency of a youth. The following shall be provided, on a form prescribed by the Division:
  - a. Total number of youths referred for competency evaluations
    - i. Gender
    - ii. Gender Identity
    - iii. Age
    - iv. Race/Ethnicity
  - b. Highest level offense associated with the referral using the appropriate Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) Code
  - c. Total number of youths referred who were deemed incompetent
  - d. Breakdown of reasons for incompetent determination using the following
    - i. Development
    - ii. Intellectual
    - iii. Mental Illness
  - e. Total number of youths recommended for restoration services
  - f. Type of restoration services provided
  - g. Total number of youths recommended for restoration services that were deemed competent

Note: Clinician/Evaluator to clearly identify (check box on competency report) reason for incompetent determination? (LCB question) Probation staff are not able to determine reason based on narrative reports.
