DRAFT LANGUAGE - CGR 508 NAC 502 ANTLER POINTS AND SPIKE ELK DEFINED

NAC 502.006 "Antler point" defined. (NRS 501.105, 501.181) "Antler point" means a projection which is at least 1 inch in length with the length exceeding the width of its base. For mule deer only, the first point on the main beam is excluded, commonly known as the eye guard.

NAC 502.104 "Spike elk" defined. (NRS 501.105, 501.181) "Spike elk" means any antlered elk having not more than *three antler points* on either antler.

NAC 502.1045 "Spike elk only" defined. (NRS 501.105, 501.181) "Spike elk only" means, in a designation of elk that may be taken during an open season, only antlered elk having not more than *three antler points on either antler*.
