AUTHORITY: NRS 453.221

A REGULATION relating to the registration of persons pursuant to NRS 453.226; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Sec. 1. NAC 453.310 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 453.310 1. A person who is required to be registered:
 - (a) May apply for registration at any time.
 - (b) Shall not engage in any activity for which registration is required until:
- (1) He or she is authorized to access the database of the program established pursuant to NRS 453.162;
- (2) Hhis or her application for registration is granted and a certificate of registration is issued to the person by the Board; and
- (3) He or she is issued a registration by the Drug Enforcement Administration to dispense controlled substances in this State and has provided a copy of that registration to the Board.
 - 2. A person who is registered may renew his or her registration biennially by:
 - (a) Ssubmitting an application for renewal;
- (b) Presenting proof that he or she is registered with the Drug Enforcement Administration to dispense controlled substances in this State; and
 - (c) **P**paying the renewal fee.
 - 3. All registrations expire on October 31 of each even-numbered year.
- **Sec. 2** Chapter 453 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as section 3 of this regulation.
- Sec 3. Registration pursuant to subsection 1 of NRS 453.226 is only valid to the extent the registrant holds a registration from the Drug Enforcement Administration to dispense controlled substances in this State.
